New Beginnings CEU Course: Mr. Pope made a motion to deny this provider (only 5 hours offered, classes appear to be braiding only). Ms. Linden seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

Salon Deliveries: Mr. Pope made a motion to deny this provider (only 5 hours offered). Ms. Linden seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

Six Figure Hairdresser: Mr. Pope made a motion to approve pending compliance (needs additional hours for sanitation). Ms. Smith seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

There was a discussion about the financial report.

Mr. McKee discussed the hiring of two temporary workers to work on the scanning project. This cost is much less than paying a company to come in and do it. He also

discussed the hiring of Maria Paulk to handle the complaints and Primus Brown as the new Inspector. He stated that the Inspectors are still finding a lot of methyl methacrylate out there and that the Investigative Committee is moving to not just fine salons but shut them down for a week.

There was a discussion about the bill to be proposed next year to regulate barbers.

Concerning *Chapter 250-X-2-.01(j)3* and 4: Mr. Pope made a motion to adopt taking the word "both" out and adding "or address change" and deleting all of 4. Ms. Bennett seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

Concerning *Chapter 250-X-5.03(1)*: Mr. Pope made a motion to add "The Board will accept hours for curricula adopted by the Alabama Department of Education for requirements toward licensure." Ms. Smith seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

The following recommendations made by the Administrative Law Judge were reviewed:

Complaint #2120 and #2162: Ms. Bennett made a motion to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation of a fine of \$1,375. Mr. Pope seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

Complaint #2169: Mr. Pope made a motion to accept the default judgment of a fine of \$875. Ms. Linden seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

Complaint #2172: Ms. Linden made a motion to accept the default judgment of a fine of \$500. Ms. Smith seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

Complaint #2203: Mr. Pope made a motion to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation of a \$1,000 fine. Ms. Bennett seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

Complaint #2204: Ms. Linden made a motion to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation of Respondent changing her personal license status from inactive to active and renew the salon license and pay fine of \$100. Mr. Pope seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

Complaint #2237: Mr. Pope made a motion to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation of a fine of \$1,000 and close salon for 7 days. Mr. Williams seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

Mr. Pope made a motion to adjourn as 12:02 p.m. All ayes.
