



ALABAMA BOARD OF COSMETOLOGY AND BARBERING

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Minutes for the Board Meeting
July 21, 2014

Ms. Smith called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. and presided over the meeting. The members present were: Floyd McDonald, Bobby Luster, General Jackson, Tracy Smith, Kathy Linden, Clifford Pope and LaTaya Aaron. A quorum of the Board members was present. The office staff members present were Jodi Respass and Carol Reynolds. Bob McKee, Executive Director, was present. Elizabeth Sheehan from the Attorney General's Office was present as legal counsel. Bobby L. Williamson with Hair Impressions in Talladega, Dave Laton and Linda Cater with the Postsecondary Department, Orson Steward, and Alisha Dunklin with J Jireh's International School of Cosmetology were present as visitors.

Mr. Pope gave the invocation. Roll call was taken.

Mr. Pope made a motion to accept the proposed minutes for the April 21, 2014 meeting as presented. Ms. Linden seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

Ms. Dunklin was not yet present (arrived at 10:17), so Ms. Reynolds read her letter and the Board discussed it.

Ms. Gwin was not present, but each Board Member was presented with a copy of her E-mail. Mr. McKee stated that her request is out of the Board's regulatory authority.

The upcoming NIC National Convention was discussed.

At 10:15, the regular meeting was adjourned and the public hearing was convened.

Mr. Pope made a motion to ratify the changes to *Chapter 250-X-5-.08*, *Chapter 250-X-5-.09* and *Chapter 250-X-5-.10*. Mr. McDonald seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

At 10:18, the public hearing was adjourned and the regular meeting was reconvened.

Ms. Dunklin addressed the Board concerning her school offering cosmetology and barbering. Her school is required to be regulated by the Board and by Jefferson County Barber Commission. The Board discussed this issue with Ms. Dunklin and explained the existing Barber Board/Commission exemption in the Law.

For Complaint #2575, Mr. McDonald made a motion to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation for a fine of \$1,000. Mr. Jackson seconded. Mr. McDonald voted yes. Mr. Luster voted yes. Mr. Jackson voted yes. Ms. Smith voted yes. Ms. Linden voted yes. Mr. Pope recused himself. Ms. Aaron voted no. The motion carried.

For Complaint #2684, Ms. Linden made a motion to amend the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation for a fine of \$1,000 and provide a copy of a pest control contract. Mr. McDonald seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

For Complaint #2693, Ms. Aaron made a motion to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation for a fine of \$1,500. Mr. Jackson seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

For Complaint #2694, Mr. Pope made a motion to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation for a fine of \$775. Mr. McDonald seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

For Complaint #2695, Ms. Linden made a motion to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation for a fine of \$2,075. Mr. Jackson seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

For Complaint #2698, Mr. McDonald made a motion to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation for a fine of \$250. Ms. Linden seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

For Complaint #2701, Mr. Pope made a motion to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation for a fine of \$300 plus court costs. Mr. Jackson seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

For Complaint #2709, Mr. Jackson made a motion to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation for a fine of \$250. Mr. Pope seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

For Complaint #2721, Mr. Pope made a motion to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation for a fine of \$1,500. Mr. Jackson seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

For Complaint #2760, Ms. Linden made a motion to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation for Color Me Beautiful and its workers to be required to be appropriately licensed by ABOCB. Mr. Luster seconded. All ayes, the motion carried.

A question had been presented to Mr. McKee concerning *Chapter 250-X-5-.03(2)* which states that "student will receive credit only for training physically conducted at a properly licensed school." One of the schools requested to take students on field trips and give the students credit for the time spent on the field trips. Ms. Sheehan stated that it's too difficult to police hours not spent in the school.

The Board Members discussed a person holding an Inactive License. Mr. Pope made a motion to remove "Inactive Renewal \$35 if applicable" from *Chapter 250-X-2-.01(e)*. Mr. McDonald seconded. Mr. Luster opposed. All others voted aye, so the motion carried.
